1. GENERAL RULES

- 1.1. Judeans undergoing the study tour should report to school at 04:00 AM.
- 1.2. Judeans need to carry the school ID card as it is required at the entry gate of certain visiting sites.
- 1.3. All school rules and the Code of Conduct apply at all times of the study tour.
- 1.4. Judeans are expected to exhibit proper courtesy, cooperation, respect and must be willing to abide by the decisions informed to them from time to time.
- 1.5. Judeans are not allowed to meet anyone who claims to be their relatives / friends etc during the study tour.
- 1.6. In addition to the first aid kit in the vehicle, an additional medical kit with first aid facilities and medicines for personal health problems should be compulsorily stocked by the Judeans in their hand bags.
- 1.7. In case of any illness, parental permission will be sought before seeking medical care.
- 1.8. Wear minimum ornaments / other valuable items during the study tour.
- 1.9. Judeans shall be always held liable for the loss of their Personal Belongings.
- 1.10. Disobedience of Judeans will be viewed seriously and dealt with accordingly.

2. LUGGAGE

- 2.1. You are allowed to bring 2 luggage:
 - 2.1.1. A handbag (Size must be smaller than the school bag - ensure that on route items, emergency medicines etc are inside it - handbag to be kept inside the bus, above the seat).
 - 2.1.2. A travel bag / suitcase (to be kept in the trunk).
- 2.2. Ensure that you carry plastic covers to store your used clothes.
- 2.3. Do include a sweater / shawl as winter season has started at the destination.
- 2.4. Don't forget to take an umbrella as slight drizzling / rain is expected.
- 2.5. Drinking water will be provided, you do not need to bring a water bottle.
- 2.6. Bring a pair of slippers as well.
- 2.7. Dress code should be modest and decent.

3. HOTEL

- 3.1. Judeans (and their parents/guardians) shall be always held liable for any damage or loss of property during the study tour.
- 3.2. Hotel rooms should be kept locked once you check in to the allotted room.
- 3.3. Strangers should not be admitted to the allotted room.
- 3.4. Money or valuables should not be left unattended in rooms.

- 3.5. There are NO MIXED GROUPS in hotel rooms, i.e., no boys in girls' rooms or vice versa.
- 3.6. Students shall be in their rooms as per the time which will be announced each night. No exceptions will be made unless there is an emergency. Students should not leave their rooms after bed check.
- 3.7. Students must be courteous to other hotel guests. There should not be any loud noises / disturbances at any time.
- 3.8. Students are not allowed to leave hotel grounds without permission from the Principal.
- 3.9. Hotel rooms are rented by and in the name of SJGS, not the individual students. Therefore, SJGS, through the accompanying staff, retains the right to enter and inspect hotel rooms used by students, if required, during the stay.

4. BE SAFE

- 4.1. Avoid misbehavior during the study tour.
- 4.2. Listen carefully when the accompanying staff gives instructions about sticking with the group or sticking with an assigned partner even when going to the restroom. Don't ever wander off.
- 4.3. Respect nature. Don't litter. Do not throw any waste materials outside the bus. You can be banned from some locations for this. Use the bin provided for the same.
- 4.4. Eat and drink in designated places only. Your destination site might have strict limitations when it comes to drinking or eating on site.
- 4.5. If a speaker/tour guide takes time out of his/her day to share wisdom with you, don't ignore it! Listen to them.

5. CONSEQUENCES

- 5.1. Any student who fails to comply with the preceding rules and regulations or who fails to cooperate with the accompanying staff may be subject to consequences at the discretion of school administration.
